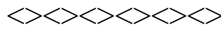

Supervisor Davis called the November 03, 2010 Dog License Law Hearing to order at 6:30 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance

The purpose of the Public Hearing was the consideration of the new dog licensing law, based upon the New York State regulations, being implemented in 2011 .

Copies of the new town law were unavailable.

Supervisor Davis opened the hearing for public comment:

Cora Donahue asked, does the new town law comply with NYS Agriculture & Markets laws dealing with the license and control of dogs.

Supervisor Davis stated that the new law was drawn up following the new guidelines from the state.

Supervisor Davis stated that the current Dog Control Law will stay in effect, with this new law dealing with the licensing of dogs only. Also, the state will still collect fees for population control of dogs.
